Every three minutes a child is born with clubfoot in the developing world. That is close to 200,000 children each year. Millions of children and adults live with this lifetime deformity that limits their ability to walk. Freddy Sanchez is a retired Major League All-Star, Two-Time World Series Champion and National League Batting Champion. Freddy was born with clubfoot deformity and his feet were corrected as an infant. He has now become an advocate for clubfoot awareness in the developing world and the mission of Ponseti International and Clubfoot Solutions. These non-profit organizations are based out of the University of Iowa with the mission of freeing the world of clubfoot deformity using the Ponseti method for clubfoot correction.
